

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal Law will be held by the Orange County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on Monday, July 11, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. local time, at the Village Offices at 811 State Route 208, at the intersection of Route 208 and Sgt. Matt Kelly Square (also known as Duelk Ave.) next to the South Blooming Grove Fire Department in the Village of South Blooming Grove, New York, in connection with the following matter:

**CLEAR KEY, LLC**, (on the Gagliardi Property) for itself or on behalf of an entity formed or to be formed (the "Company"), has submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency requesting the Agency's assistance with respect to a certain project (the "Project") consisting of (i) the acquisition by the Agency of a leasehold or other interest in an approximately 11±-acre parcel of land located on State Route 208 in the Village of South Blooming Grove, Orange County, New York [TMID #: Part of 219-1-1] (the "Land"), (ii) the construction on the Land of an approximately 40,000 square-foot Sleep Inn & Suites hotel (the "Improvements"); and (iii) the acquisition and installation in, on and around the Improvements of certain items of equipment and other tangible personal property, including, but not limited to, beds, dressers, carpeting, tables, chairs, HVAC systems, plumbing and electrical fixtures and elevators (collectively, the "Equipment" and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility").

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term, the Agency's leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of sales and use tax exemptions, a mortgage recording tax exemption and a real property tax abatement, all consistent with the policies of the Agency unless procedures for deviation are complied with.

A representative of the Agency will be at the above-stated time and place to present a copy of the Company's Project Application (including a cost-benefit analysis) and hear and accept written and oral comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to or otherwise relevant to the proposed Financial Assistance.
