18 ROUTE 17K, LLC, for itself or on behalf of an entity formed or to be formed (the "Company"), has submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency requesting the Agency's assistance with respect to a certain project (the "Project") consisting of: (i) the acquisition by the Agency of a leasehold interest in an approximately 7.3±-acre portion of an approximately 97.8± parcel of land located at 18 Route 17K in the Town of Newburgh, Orange County, New York [TMID #: 97-1-21.2] (the "Land"), (ii)(A) the renovation of an approximately 9,600 square-foot building, 22,000 square-foot commercial garage and a 2-car wash building located on the Land (the "Existing Improvements"), and (B) the construction of an approximately 66,000 square-foot addition to the Existing Improvements (the "Improvements") to be used by the Company for its fabrication operations and related office space; and (iii) the acquisition and installation in, on and around the Improvements of certain items of equipment and other tangible personal property (collectively, the "Equipment" and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility").

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term, the Agency's leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of sales and use tax exemptions, a mortgage recording tax exemption and a real property tax abatement, all consistent with the policies of the Agency unless procedures for deviation are complied with.

A representative of the Agency will be at the above-stated time and place to present a copy of the Company's Project Application (including a cost-benefit analysis) and hear and accept written and oral comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to or otherwise relevant to the proposed Financial Assistance.
