7		Industrial Development Agency, I will be
8		conducting the public hearing. To my right is
9		Kelly Reilly, one of our administrative staff

L1		stenographer who is taking down everything that's

2	WOOD PRODUCTS, INC., a corporation duly organized
3	and validly existing under the laws of the State
4	of New York, for itself or on behalf of an entity
5	formed or to be formed, has submitted an
6	application to the Agency requesting the Agency's
7	assistance with respect to a certain project
8	consisting of: (A) the acquisition by the Agency
9	of a leasehold interest in an approximately 20
10	plus/minus acre parcel of land located at 120
11	Neelytown Road in the Town of Hamptonburgh,
12	Orange County, New York; (B) the construction on
13	the Land of an approximately 50,000 square foot
14	manufacturing/warehousing building; and (C) the
15	acquisition and instllation in, on and around the
16	Improvements of certain items of equipment and
17	other tangible personal property including, but
18	not limited to, mechanicals, plumbing, lighting,
19	fixtures and furnishings; and, together with the
20	Land and the Improvements; all for use as a wood
21	pallet manufacturing/warehousing space, of which
22	a portion may be subleased to various tenants.
23	The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in
24	the Facility and lease the Facility back to the
25	Company. The Company will operate the Facility

during the term of the lease. At the end of the
lease term, the Agency's leasehold interest will
be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it
will provide financial assistance to the Company
in the form of sales and use tax exemptions, a
mortgage recording tax exemption and a partial
real property tax abatement, all consistent with
the policies of the Agency unless procedures for

MR. DOWD: Thank you. So according to the application, the total capital costs of the project is \$3.9 million, the applicant also has a \$705,000 CFA grant in the State of New York.

MR. MC NEILLY: That's correct.

MR. DOWD: The sales tax exemptions requested are approximately \$97,500 for construction, \$24,375 for equipment, the mortgage recording tax is approximately \$22,500 and they're requesting a ten year PILOT which according to Orange County Real Property Services estimates that the total savings over the ten year period would be \$473,074. McNeilly presently employs 51 full time equivalent employees, within three years of this project being completed they expect to hire an additional 20. Anything misstated there?

MR. MC NEILLY: No.

MR. DOWD: With that, I'll open up to any comments from anyone in the public? No one?

There being no public comment, I would declare the public hearing closed. I thank you all for
